## 2015 Programs

### **Midwife Training Programs:**

Completed in Pucallpas, Peru (see photo) and SanAntonio de Esmoruco Bolivia, 20 midwives trained and supplied

# Community Health Worker Training:

Training for 30 women working in impoverished communities around Pucallpas, Peru. The CHWs will visit all pregnant women to ensure they get care for pregnancy and delivery.

# Physician Training for Contraceptive Implants:

We are offering free long-term family planning to 500 women.

## Physician Training in Basic Ultrasound:

25 physicians working in remote areas will be trained to help identify women with pregnancy problems before labor. Portable ultrasound units are being donated later this year.

#### Birth Centers (Sala de Partos):

Construction of 2 delivery suites in clinics serving remote areas in Bolivia, so that women can be close to emergency equipment and supplies at the time of birth.

**Bathrooms:** We are on track to complete 130 more bathrooms this year (see Juan Carlos above).

#### Clean Water:

This month we are completing a water project in Molino serving 200 people. We are also currently assessing the next project - to serve the larger town of Oploca Bolivia.
